

Vacancy - Research Investigators- CCR, WBNUJS

The Centre for Child Rights, WBNUJS is looking to hire a "Research Investigator" for a project on evaluation of the Protection of Children From Sexual Offences Act. The tasks that the research investigators are expected to perform are:

- i. Administration of Interview tools and questionnaires to various categories of respondents.
- ii. Collect data from court-case records
- iii. Conduct FGDs and KIIs
- iv. Collect observational data.
- v. Report to the research team about data collected in prescribed format.

The job will involve a considerable amount of travel to all locations in West Bengal and is a full time commitment.

Essential Qualifications:

1. Graduation in law or in any social science discipline (candidates who are pursuing graduation in law or in a social science discipline can also apply)
2. Working knowledge in English and Bangla

Preferred Qualifications:

1. Prior experience in filed research, especially pertaining to implementation of laws.
2. Exposure to court cases, and court documents.

The salary for the post is a consolidated sum of Rs.10,000 per month only. The appointment will be a contractual one, which will initially be for a period of one month and further extended up to another five months.
