

Certificate Course on Child Rights and Child Protection in India

Centre for Child Rights, WBNUJS (in partnership with UNICEF)

The Centre for Child Rights, WBNUJS (in partnership with UNICEF) announces the launch of a Certificate Course on Child Rights and Child Protection in India. The course will introduce the participants to the global and national perspectives on Child Rights. Emphasis would be laid on the theoretical underpinnings of the concept of 'child' and 'childhood', while contextualizing child rights and child protection in the broader framework of human rights in India. At the end of the course, the participants should be (i) Familiar with child protection laws in India and their implementation (ii) Capable of drawing interlinkages between the different child protection laws (iii) Aware of the important debates and contested domains of child rights and child protection (iv) Acquainted with the administrative framework for child protection at the state and national level. To this end, the Course consists of the following modules:

- Introduction to child and childhood
- Child rights - International and National framework
- Constitution of India and Rights of the Child
- Civil Laws and the Child
- Criminal Processes and the Child
- National & State Policies for Children

Course Duration: 40 hours over 3 months with classes on weekends (at least 80% attendance is compulsory)*

Evaluation: A written examination (proctored)

Course Fee: INR 5000 (inclusive of all costs, including reading materials)

Eligibility: The Course is open to all. Social workers, those persons associated with civil society organizations, child rights advocates, Panchayati Raj Institutions, employees of government departments working on child rights issues, health workers, students of law and students from other social science backgrounds etc. are encouraged to attend.
