- The citations must be typewritten in font: Times New Roman, font size: 10, line spacing: 1.0 and alignment: justified;
- References must be cited in footnotes following the OSCOLA style;
- One inch margin must be kept on all sides of the manuscript;
- An abstract of not more than 300 words must be included with the submission;
- Co-authorship is allowed subject to a maximum of two. Full names and contact details of all the authors must be given;
- Each author are allowed to submit a maximum of one submission. In case of multiple submissions by author(s), the 2nd and subsequent entries would be disregarded.
- The manuscript must be accompanied with a covering letter specifying the author's name, designation, institute, contact number and e-mail for future reference.
- The author(s) bear(s) sole responsibility for the accuracy of facts, opinions or view stated in the submitted manuscript. In case contents of the submitted manuscript are found to be plagiarised, the manuscript shall be subject to immediate rejection.
- The following is the word limit of submitted manuscript(s):
 - o Articles: A maximum of 5000 words, including footnotes;
 - o Essays: A maximum of 3000 words, including footnotes;
 - o Case Notes: A maximum of 1500 words, including footnotes;
 - o Book Reviews: A maximum of 1000 words.
