Global experience and research have established that diversified educational institutions produce better results than the institutions which lack diversity.

Brief experience with the National Law Universities around the country also indicates that they are not serving the social needs as well as they should primarily for the reason that their admission policy attracts only a particular segment of the society. Discussions on the policy change have been initiated. But until change takes place let us make individual and collective efforts to attract and encourage eligible candidates in different, especially disadvantaged, segments of the society such as the rural and semi rural areas by spreading awareness and promising support.

Although we are late for admissions this year, a few days are still left to inform and encourage the eligible candidates. Enough time is, however, available for organizing help in qualifying CLAT for those candidates from these disadvantaged and excluded segments of the society who have already applied for it.
