About School of Criminal Justice Administration (SCJA)

The principles governing the interplay of criminal laws with the School and its conception of morality form the core of this School of Criminal Justice Administration. Considering the perennial importance of law and crime in any civilized society and given the increasing awareness regarding individual and collective human rights, the field of criminal justice has attained greater social significance than ever before. The role of criminal justice interventions in producing safe and just societies cannot be emphasized more upon, and the School aims at fulfilling its greater responsibility towards the Society. In doing so, the School follows an interdisciplinary approach that extends to sociological and jurisprudential aspects of criminal justice, as well as to the non-criminal branches of law. In addition to the socio-legal edge the contemporary relevance of its functioning serves to raise the interest quotient of this School, making it one of the most active academic venture at the University.

About NUJS

The West Bengal National University of Juridical Sciences was established under the WBNUJS Act, 1999 (West Bengal Act IX of 1999) adopted by the West Bengal Legislature in July, 1999. The University was notified under Clause (f) of Section 2 of the UGC Act, 1956 in August 2004 and has been granted permanent affiliation by the Bar Council of India in July 2005. On 28 October 2002, the university's present-day permanent campus was inaugurated by the then Chief Justice of India, B. N. Kirpal. The NUJS, Kolkata, along with the GNLU and NLSIU, Bengaluru, remain the only National Law Schools which have the Honourable Chief Justice of India as the Chancellor. This set-up provides an aura of exclusivity and rare stature to these National Law Schools in India. NUJS is considered as one of the best amongst the elite National Law Schools in India which are developed on the five-year law degree model, as proposed and implemented by the Bar Council of India. The university offers a five-year integrated B.A./BSc. LLB (Hons.) degree programme at the undergraduate level and a Master of Laws (LLM) programme at the postgraduate level. Admission to the former programme is through the Common Law Admission Test, a highly competitive, nationwide common entrance examination, held jointly by the National Law Schools. NUJS also offers MPhil & Ph.D. The Chief Justice of India is the Chancellor of NUJS and is also the Chairman of the General Council, the supreme policy-making body of the University. Currently Prof. (Dr.) Nirmal Kanti Chakrabarti is the Vice Chancellor of the University.

About Kolkata:



Kolkata has been called the "City of Joy" as well as the "cultural capital of India." The city of Kolkata, situated on the eastern bank of the river Ganges, can boast of having most listed and recorded heritage buildings viz. the Victoria Memorial, National Library, Shaheed Minar, Eden Gardens, Indian Museum - the oldest in India established in 1814, Dakshineswar Temple etc. Other places of attraction in the city include the Marble Palace (a privately owned collection of eclectic sculptures, paintings and a small menagerie and aviary built by Raja Rajendra Mullick in 1835, which houses, among other treasures two little-publicized Reubens and a Joshua Reynolds paintings, not to mention over 50 varieties of marble which grace the interiors of this mansion) and the Jorasanko Thakur Bari (the ancestral home of Rabindranath Tagore that was the cultural hub of Kolkata for close to a century and was a major force in the women's liberation and the Independence movements and has three large galleries. The river Hooghly is bridged by iconic structures to link the twin cities of Kolkata on the east and Howrah on the west. All the bridges viz. Rabindra Setu (Howrah Bridge), Vidyasagar Setu (Second Hooghly Bridge), Nivedita Setu (Second Vivekananda Bridge), Vivekananda Bridge is classic examples of bridge structures. The Science City, at a distance of only 2 km from the venue of the conference, is also a place major attraction for all. One of the other major attractions around Kolkata is the vast reserved forest area of Sunderbans that is the habitat of many flora & fauna, including the famous Royal Bengal Tigers.
