Introduction to NASCAP

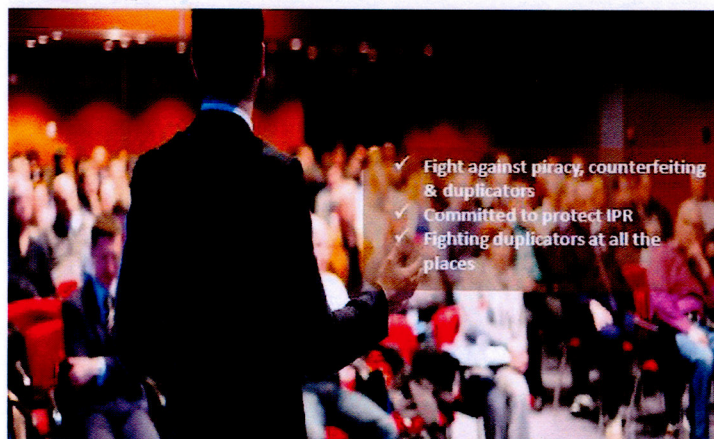
